



## Ashbourne Primary School Aspirations Action Plan 2024-2025

### Strengths from last year:

- In KS2 many clubs had a high number of PP and SEND children take part.
- 122 children completed the Aspirations Award.
- A range of clubs were on offer at lunch time and after school.
- Successful summer play.
- All staff ran a club.
- The majority of PP and SEND children took part in extra curriculum sporting activities.
- Careers week widened the children's horizons with the different speakers that came in.
- Children talked positively about the Aspirations Award.
- Children enjoyed having clubs at lunch time.

### Development points from last year:

- To engage parents with careers week.
- To engage more PP and SEN children to complete the Aspirations Award.
- To encourage more KS1 SEND and PP children to take part in clubs.
- To ensure there are more club opportunities for KS1.
- Look at more sporting events for KS1.
- Send Aspirations books home for half term so that children can start them during the holidays.

### Priorities for this year

1. Raise aspirations of the children at Ashbourne Primary School by widening and extending children's experiences and their knowledge of aspirational people/events.
2. Engage parents with the Aspirations topic.
3. To provide more opportunities for KS1 across the school year.
4. To increase the number of SEND and PP children participating in the Aspirations Topic.

### Success Criteria

- Children will have been exposed to new role models.
- Children are able to articulate their learning through pupil voice and voice their aspirations.
- Children will be more confident in explaining their aspirations.
- Children's experiences will be widened and extended.
- Children will achieve the school PRAISE aim of self-motivation.
- Children can name and talk about an aspirational person.
- Majority of children will take part in the whole-school 'Aspirations Awards'.
- KS1 children will have opportunities to take part in sports or clubs.
- Teachers to promote the Aspiration booklet in class and join in with completing the booklet with the children.
- Teachers to run clubs that link with the 'Aspiration Awards' during Summer 2.
