

Diversity topic review

We have a really successful diversity topic over the spring term with lots of exciting things happening in school!

Attendance to the RE places of worship has significantly increased this year. In Year 3 and 4, 42/48 (87.5%) attended the Mandir temple. In Year 5, 28/31 (90%) attended the Mosque. In Year 6, 42/45 (93%) attended the faith trail.

The children loved Around The World Week and the dance festival.

One child stated, 'we even got to try Feta cheese and olives!'

The majority of children defined diversity as 'difference' and listed numerous ways we can be different.

The children could name a number of ways humans can be neurodivergent e.g ADHD, Autism.

Some children shared that they had used their homework projects to teach people at home – 'Mum and dad didn't know what diversity meant until I explained it to them. Dad had to Google it.'
