

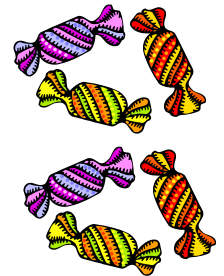

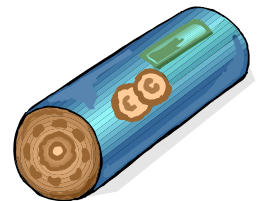
Tom had 26 coins in a piggy bank. His dad gave him 6 more coins as pocket money. How many coins does he have now?
